Accommodation Tax Bylaw No. 3632, 2016

ADOPTED August 8, 2016

PURPOSE

This bylaw sets out to impose a tax on accommodation under the Provisions of the Provincial Sales Tax Act.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Campbell River wishes to raise revenue for the purposes of financing tourism marketing, programs and projects;

AND WHEREAS under section 240 of the Provincial Sales Tax Act, a municipality may request that the Lieutenant Governor in Council make a regulation imposing, on behalf of the municipality, an additional tax not exceeding three (3) percent of purchase price of accommodation sold within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Campbell River, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

PART 1: Title

1.1 This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as **Accommodation Tax Bylaw No. 3632, 2016.**

PART 2: Administration

- 2.1 The Lieutenant Governor in Council is hereby requested to make a regulation under sections 240 Provincial Sales Tax Act declaring that effective January 1, 2017, section 123(1) of the said Act applies in respect of accommodation purchased within the City of Campbell River.
- 2.2 The tax to be imposed under the provisions of the regulation is requested to be three (3) percent of the purchase price of accommodation.
- 2.3 The funds paid to the City of Campbell River under the provisions of the regulation shall be applied to tourism marketing, programs and projects.


