
### — P R O C L A M A T I O N —

- WHEREAS** the Lighthouse Centre serves approximately 20,000 hot meals a year and meets with clients on a daily basis for referrals to treatment for drug and alcohol abuse;
- AND WHEREAS** In partnership with BC housing, the Salvation Army provides 15 low barrier extreme weather shelter mats at their Lighthouse Centre during the coldest months of the year;
- AND WHEREAS** over 400 local households are assisted annually with vouchers for clothing and household supplies through our thrift stores as well as emergency food hampers;
- AND WHEREAS** in partnership with the local business community and generous individuals last year their Adopt a Family program helped approximately 50 local families with Christmas food and toy hampers;
- AND WHEREAS** in partnership with B.C. Housing up to 22 warm beds per night for individuals and families are provided at their Evergreen House facility;
