2019 CONSTRUCTION WORK BEGINS

Construction of new water and sewer lines along Highway 19A, between 1st Ave and Rockland Road, is set to start mid-May.

In April, Council awarded the construction contracts for the underground service upgrades to Wacor Holdings Ltd.

Specifically, this work includes:

- Installation of a new, larger sewer pipe from 1st Ave to Rockland Road
- Installation of a new watermain in the one kilometre southern portion of this stretch

This underground work is expected to carry through the summer months and be complete by late fall 2019 (see page two for more info on construction in 2020).

During construction, two-way traffic will be largely maintained, although one-way alternating traffic will be needed at times and could be implemented without notice. Keep in mind, commuters will be travelling through two work areas during this time, and delays are expected.

There will also be impact on the seawalk, which will be localized to the direct area under construction. Contractors will ensure routes around the work zone, but pedestrians should note that the regular flow will be disrupted – watch for detour signs posted on site.

Thank you for your patience as this important work on the Waterfront Project 2018-2020 progresses.



During work in 2018, the road between the Maritime Heritage Centre and 1st Ave was temporarily repaved. In April, crews finalized paving along this stretch.



Highway 19A will remain open, but traffic will move slowly. If possible, or in a hurry, consider rerouting to one of these routes.

 <p>PHASE 2A New forcemain will be installed from 1st Ave to Big Rock Boat Ramp.</p>	<p>PHASE 2B Three lift stations (# 4, 5 & 6) will be built (off of roadways) between Maritime Heritage Centre and Rockland Road.</p>
 <p>PHASE 3A New watermain & forcemain will be installed from Big Rock Boat Ramp to just south of Rockland Road.</p>	<p>PHASE 3B Highway 19A surface renewals, including construction of a roundabout at Rockland Road. This work will require a highway closure near Rockland Road.</p>
