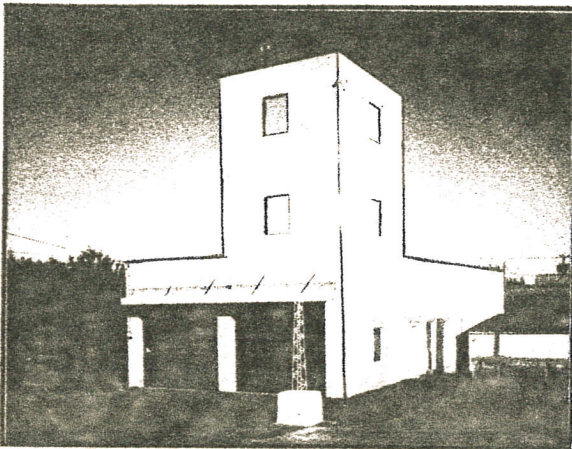
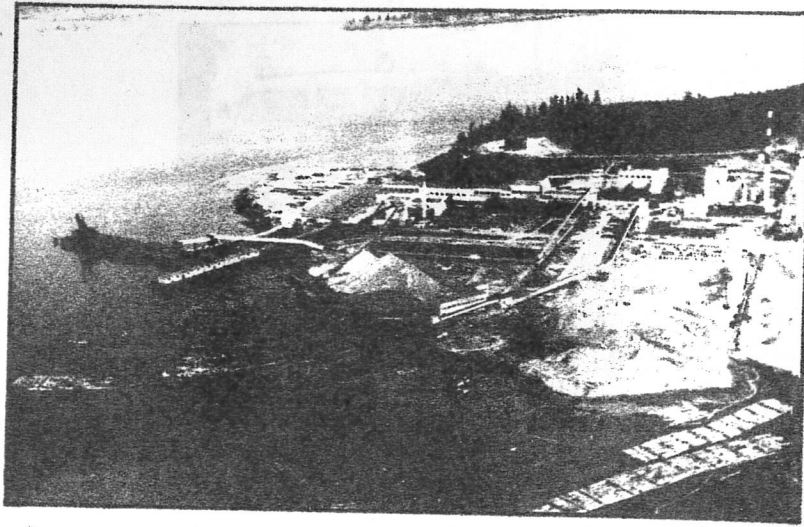

Thank You for a job well done.

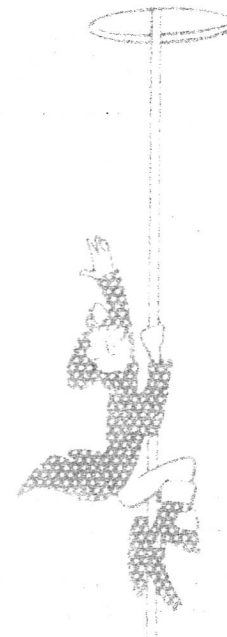

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK  
Oct. 8th to Oct. 14th, 1961

REPORT OF ACTIVITIES :

This year in conjunction with Corker & Ibbotson Insurance Agents and Norton Agencies, we started the Junior Fire Marshal's programme in the Elementary Schools. We gave talks and demonstrations to approximately 700 school children at the following schools; Maple School Cedar School, Cedar School Annex and Discovery School. Also talks were given to the Grade Seven classes and demonstrations on the handling of small extinguishers, at the High School Annex.

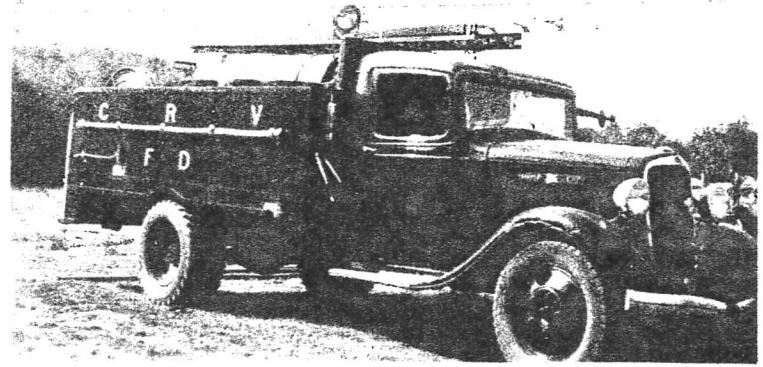
On the Friday of Fire Prevention Week, The Chief, Mr. Corker and myself presented the children at all the above schools, with their Junior Fire Marshal's Helmets and the Honor Roll for each Class, to the teachers for the various Class Rooms. The Principals and Teachers were very impressed with our Fire Prevention Programme, and expressed the hope that we would be able to carry this on again next year.

Further to this of the approximately 600 Junior Fire Marshal Contest Booklets distributed, the return of the same was 100% and they were filled in completely and accurately and it was gratifying to all of us that the youngster took such a keen interest,

Some of the remarks passed by various parents and others interested, were quite humorous, as some of the situations the children forced on them, to do their duty to prevent fires, caused many of them to sit up and take notice,

Finally, we are hoping this year to expand our efforts, and we hope to cover all schools in our District. With the co-operation of the Insurance Agents and the teaching staff, we feel sure we will be able to accomplish this. To the Parents we also say Thank You and remind everyone BE CAREFULL, PREVENT FIRES as the LIFE you save may be your own.

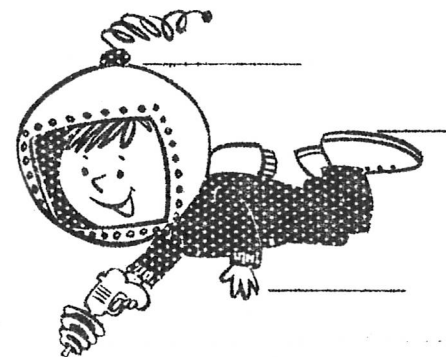

#### WHISTLEPUNK

A member of the Department since its inception, Mrs. Agnes Thulin is more than a mascot. When the Chief is away either on inspection duty or fighting fires, Mrs. Thulin mans the 2 Way Radio. She sends last minute instructions by radio to the Chief's car and the trucks.

Why is she called Whistlepunk? When the Dept. was started in 1942 there was no way of sending out any automatic alarms. We had an Air Marine Whistle on top of the Garage with a whistle wire to the outside of the building. When there was a fire call by phone, she rushed outside and kept pulling the wire until a crew turned up. We had 10 short blasts for a signal of fire. In later years there was confusion with the sound being the same as the seine boats, so when money was available we went to the Gamewell Air Horn Automatic System, which has been in operation since 1950.

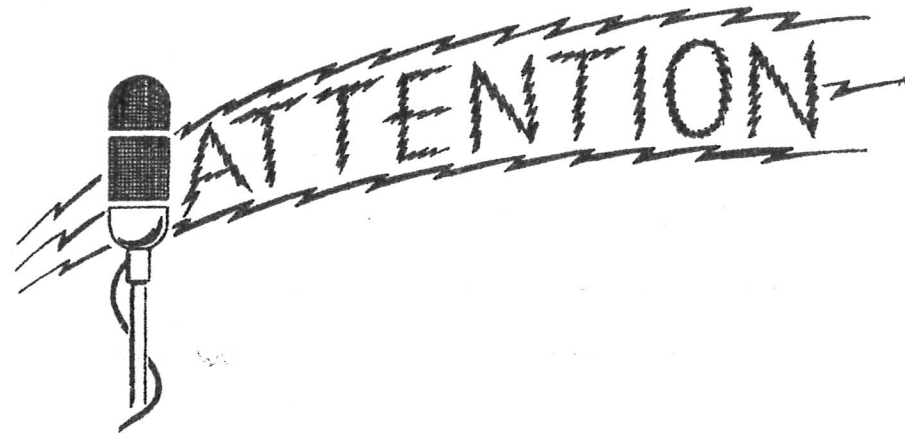

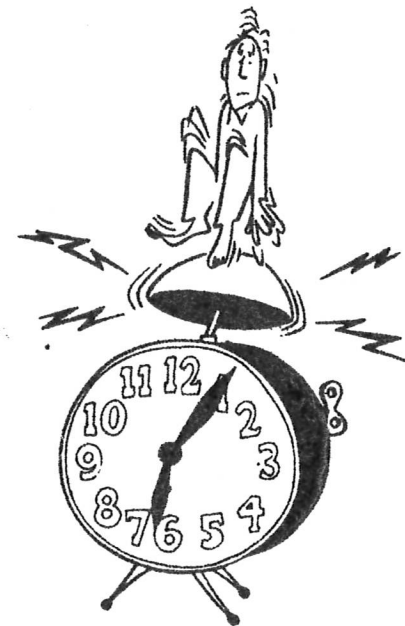

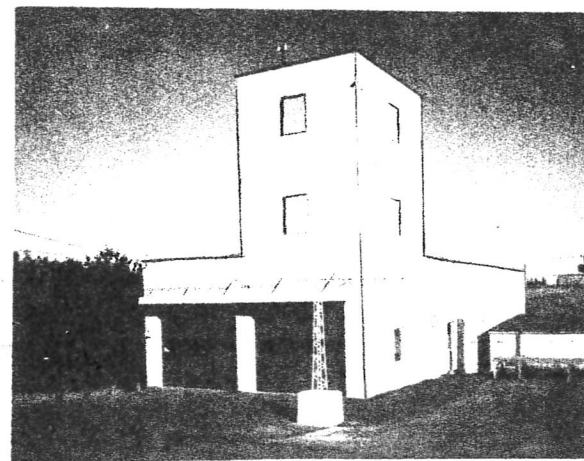

OUR NEW TRAINING TOWER, GARAGE AND WORK SHOP

The need for a training tower has been felt for the last few years. We used to practice on other peoples buildings, doing damage to their roofs etc. We tried not too, but this is impossible with 25 men on practices, besides the practice was very limited and in the dark.

Now with our new training tower we can go into all types of actual fire practices, the only exception being there is no flame. We have smoke bombs for actual smoke practices with masks etc., We have a 4x4 foot dummy roof in a hatch on the roof. The building can be filled with smoke and then actual ventilation carried out by cutting out the false roof.

Smokey our dummy lives on the top floor. He has his own bed and chairs. This is to add realism to the job at hand. The inside of the tower has stairs leading to the roof level and is used for hose advancement up stairs. This is a tricky operation, to be able to land at the top level with enough hose to fight a fire at that level.
