Campbell River Airport Authority Directors

The City of Campbell River's Airport Authority, a Commission of the City of Campbell River, oversees the operations of the Campbell River Airport on behalf of Mayor and Council. The City is currently seeking three (3) new volunteers to act as Members of the Airport Authority for a three-year term. Members of the Campbell River Airport Authority should have a commitment to excellence in policy governance and the skills, knowledge and experience necessary to carry out the duties of the Commission. The Commission is responsible for setting policy, monitoring and delivering to the Mayor and Council, as owners, the end results set by the Mayor and Council on behalf of the City. Bylaw 3444 establishes the Airport Authority. Candidates should be able to demonstrate knowledge and experience in the aviation industry, economic development, governance or governmental finance or operations. Positions are open to local and regional candidates. Interested persons should submit a brief resume and covering letter setting out how they could contribute to the role of Airport Authority Member. We thank all applicants for their interest; however only those candidates selected for an interview will be contacted. If you have applied in the past, you are still required to make a new application to be considered for this review process.

Responses must be received by 4:00 pm on October 19, 2015.


